Code of Conduct for Participants

This Code of Conduct for Participants is designed to ensure an enjoyable and dynamic conference here at CIMUN 2019. Violation of this code may lead to disciplinary action at the discretion of the CIMUN Organizing Committee, whose word remains final.

THE CODE:

_____, [*Participant Name*] would like to participate in The Cathedral International Model United Nations 2019, held at and hosted by The Cathedral Vidya School, Lonavala, from the 20th of September to the 22nd of September, 2019.

1. Conduct of responsibility of the Participant

a. Participants will not bring, use, or attempt to use, the following prohibited items at the conference.

- Alcohol
- Cigarettes
- Weapons
- Recreational Drugs
- Explosive items, including pyrotechnics and naked flames
- Living animals or birds.

b. Participants will be honest and treat others with dignity, respect, and courtesy, in a manner that will not interfere with the rights of others. This includes refraining from the use of inappropriate language, actions, or attire. Participants may not, at any time, harass others verbally or physically, or even incite or encourage such harassment. If any participant deems an activity harassing, (s)he is to inform the CIMUN Organizing Committee immediately. Harassment includes, but is not limited to:

- Any kind of discrimination based on:
 - Race
 - Religion
 - Gender
 - Nationality
 - Sexual Orientation

- Age
 - Disability

- Excessive Noise
 - Photographing/ Digital Recording/Inappropriate viewing with or without usage of any other device without prior permission
 - Subjection of any person to any action against his/her will
 - Unauthorised access to another person's possessions
 - Theft, or the unauthorised borrowing of another person's possessions
 - Modification of others' personal possessions, without their prior consent or knowledge.
- c. Participants realize the importance of punctuality and fully agree to arrive at the conference on time and to attend all possible committee sessions while complying with the conference rules and regulations.
- d. Participants are expected to be dressed in formal attire for the duration of the conference and to follow the respective dress codes for social events. Participants who wear clothing that exposes too much bare skin or is otherwise revealing or immodest may be asked to change into appropriate attire before being permitted into committee or admitted to social events. The decision as to what constitutes revealing or immodest attire rests with the CIMUN Organizing Committee and is unarguable. The participant must wear the Conference Badge at all times during the conference.
- e. The CIMUN Information Technology Policy permits access to dongles, laptops, and cell phones; though WiFi access will be granted to a participant's personal electronics.
- f. Participants may not litter, vandalize or otherwise damage CVSL property in any way. They will not attempt to obstruct to interfere with

conference and production equipment, unless granted permission to do so by the CIMUN Organizing Committee.

- g. Participants may not indulge in any self-organized promotional activity, including but not limited to those for charity, without prior written permission of the CIMUN Organizing Committee.
- h. Participants will not attempt to leave the conference venue without notifying the CIMUN Organizing Committee unless they are commuting to or from the hotel, or self-organized residence, at designated times.

2. Liability of the Participant

- a. CIMUN cannot be held accountable or responsible for any personal belongings or other personal items of value.
- b. The participant will be held accountable for any damage or vandalism of the conference venue.

3. Consent

- a. Participants' consents to their being photographed and reporting for the purpose of the CIMUN Press.
- b. In case of any medical emergency, CIMUN may administer the appropriate medical help for which the participant will be 100% liable.

I understand that violation of this code or of the Conference Rules and Regulations may lead to any disciplinary action the CIMUN Organizing Committee deems fit and promise to abide by the code and aforementioned regulations.
